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YORK REVOLUTION PARTNERS WITH NEW HOPE ACADEMY TO OFFER STUDENT INTERSHIPS

Parents to learn about internships, family services during tonight's Parent Resource Fair

YORK, Pa. (Nov. 18, 2010) – In a partnership that offers a unique learning experience for students, York Revolution Professional Baseball has teamed up with New Hope Academy Charter School to provide its top students with an opportunity to intern with the team.

“The goal is to provide talented students an opportunity to learn business and workplace behavioral skills,” said R. Eric Menzer, president of York Revolution Professional Baseball. “We are happy to partner with New Hope Academy to offer spring and summer internships, giving select students unprecedented access to learn all aspects of our operations.”

One intern will serve from January through March and will perform administrative, sales, marketing, finance and operations tasks. This spring intern will work approximately 6 hours per week during after-school hours. Two students will serve from April through August and will handle administrative, marketing and game-operations tasks. These summer interns must be available to work at least 45 home baseball games on evenings and weekends in addition to weekday, daytime hours. Summer interns will work approximately 6 hours per week during after-school hours prior to end of school year, and then 40 hours per week after the end of the school term. All three interns will receive a small stipend.

Juniors and seniors at New Hope Academy will be eligible to apply for the internship program, and final selection of all interns will be made by York Revolution Professional Baseball. Students must receive the recommendation of a guidance counselor and at least one teacher to participate and must maintain good academic and disciplinary standing in school to remain in the program.

Parents will learn about the York Revolution internships during the Parent Resource Fair, to be

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held tonight from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. in the multi-purpose room at New Hope Academy Charter School, 459 W. King St., York. The fair is being held in conjunction with parent-teacher conferences and report cards. It will provide parents with an opportunity to learn about services available for their families.
